Dear Friends,

As many of you, or your colleagues will be going away over the summer and hopefully relaxing and enjoying the sunshine, I will keep this letter short and update you all in September with our goings on over the summer.

Last month we processed 28 vouchers, which represented 41 Adults and 19 Children, making a total of food supplied to 60 people, or food for 540 meals. The main reason for needing a voucher was low income followed by Benefit delays.

SCHOOL HOLIDAY MEALS

We are pleased to say that we have been having a steady flow of families coming in to pick up food for their children during the school holidays. It has been a great bonus to our families that we now have access to fresh produce because of the Tesco FairShare initiative. We are also grateful to Chuckie Eggs who have supplied us with eggs to give out as well.
